It will replace the usual SHARE Collection. CROSSCARE is involved in a wide variety of social projects in the Archdiocese of Dublin. Since it was founded over 70 years ago CROSSCARE has continued to seek to redress poverty and social exclusion.

It continues to develop new and innovative programmes and to sponsor new research to help inform policies on combating poverty and exclusion. *There are some information leaflets available at the back of the Church, please take one home with you.*

SVC1 was the registration plate on the little Skoda Rapid that Pope Francis used for his travels around Dublin. Now that he has returned to the Vatican the car has been donated to charity.

Maybe you heard that Crosscare received the car from Skoda and they gave it to the hub in Mater DEI. This new facility on Clonliffe Road has transformed a building previously used for education to be a temporary residence for homeless families awaiting more permanent accommodations. When they are being moved from the hub to a new home they will be driven in the Pope's car!

Earlier this year Clonskeagh parish made their donation to Crosscare to give settling in packs to these families consisting of all the bits and pieces they might need to settle into their new place. It's great to think that our packs will be in the boot of the Pope's car.

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

A new European Data Protection law, the General Data Protection Regulation (“GDPR”), was introduced on 25 May 2018. This new law applies to any organisation, including our parish that manages and processes people's personal information. We are now working on ways of ensuring that what we do with your information is compliant with this new law. It is a work in progress and over the next few months we will keep you informed through the parish website as policies are put in place. Faith for Life

Faith for Life is an adult faith course designed to help you to discover more energising and empowering ways to live out your faith in the reality of today's world through relationships, family, home, workplaces and the events of daily life. It aims to help you to be more active, open, faithful, confident, trusting and willing to work for change. The Faith for Life course is experienced as a journey of four ‘Movements’ inviting you to explore the call you received in Baptism. The process for each weekend includes teaching, personal and group reflection, prayer and liturgy. The course is run over four weekends: 6/7 October 2018, 17/18 November 2018, 12/13 January 2019 and 23/24 February 2019. This course has been designed and is delivered through a partnership agreement between the Archdioceses of Dublin and Liverpool. Upon completion, participants will be awarded a Certificate of Achievement.
