## BISHOPS' CONFERENCE – SUMMER MEETING STATEMENT

Members of the Irish Catholic Bishops' Conference gathered this week at St Patrick's College, Maynooth, for their Summer 2024 General Meeting. The President of the Conference is Archbishop Eamon Martin of Armagh, and the Vice-President is Archbishop Farrell. **Bishops welcomed and offered prayers for the ministry of the newest Conference member, Bishop Donal Roche, Auxiliary Bishop of Dublin, whose episcopal ordination took place on Trinity Sunday.** The main issues discussed by bishops during their Summer meeting were:

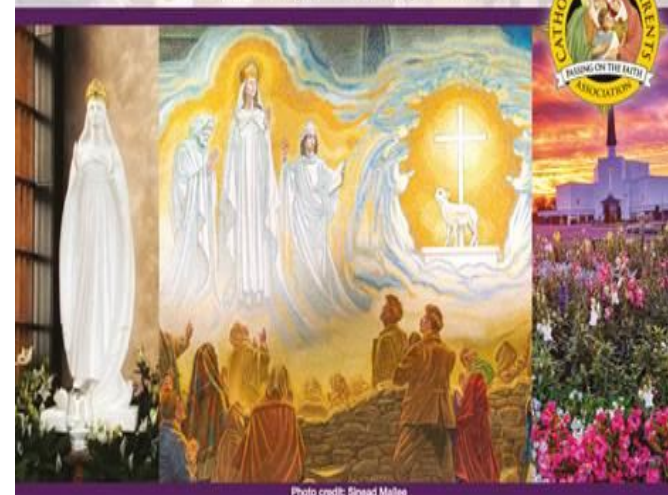
- Bishops welcome Pope Francis's message for the Jubilee Year of Hope 2025

- Plight of migrants and refugees in Ireland – Bishops to write Pastoral Letter on Immigration

- Prayers and call for cessation of Israel/Hamas war - "a catastrophe for humanity"
